Tri-County R & WM Report

Tentative Township Cleanup dates have been set. The seasonal worker will start on the 16th of March if he is able to start then.

Veteran's Assistance and Van Report

Veteran's Superintendent Ric Smart presented the monthly report. Ten veterans were given assistance in February amounting to \$ 2,394.89. The transportation van made 13 trips to Iowa City transporting 35 Veterans.

Chief Deputy Nick Petitgout presented the monthly report. The average jail population was 42 last month. They have made arrests for burglary and a drug "bust". A tentative agreement has been reached with the Union.
