

ROAD & BRIDGE COMMITTEE

The McDonough County Road and Bridge Committee held a meeting on Wednesday, June 15, 2016 at 6:30 P.M. The meeting was held at the McDonough County Courthouse, 3rd Floor Law Library. Committee members present were Vice Chairman Dave Cortelyou, Dick Marcott, Rod McGrew, Earl Sims, Trevor Toland, Paul Trimmer, Jerry Tyson and McDonough County Board Chairman Scott Schwerer. Member Clarke Kelso was absent. Beth Crossett was present as recording secretary. Other persons present included: County Engineer Tom Hickman.

Vice Chairman Cortelyou called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

Resolution to Accept Bids to Furnish & Deliver Materials for 2016 Federal PPP

Tom reported he checked on the CA-16 to make sure that it is Class C or better from Central Stone, and it is. Member Toland moved with second by Member McGrew to pass to the full Board Resolution to Accept Bids to Furnish and Deliver Materials for 2016 Federal Pavement Preservation Program. Motion carried on a voice vote.

Resolution for County Aid Project #1530-83

Tom checked on the lower bid and they did not comply with the specs. He did talk to Metal Culverts, Inc. and they had an Engineering firm prepare the bid and it was not complete. Member Sims moved with second by Member McGrew to pass to the full Board Resolution for County Aid Project #1530-83. Motion carried on a voice vote.

Other Business

Board Chairman Schwerer asked Tom if he had asked Mr. Dunn to cost share the invoice for Gunther, Tom has not approached him about the bill but did talk to him today. Mr. Dunn said he would be sending Mr. Buyers to inspect the blacktop today or tomorrow. Tom said that they looked at the Tennessee/Blandinsville blacktop on Friday and put down sand to blot. Dave drove the blacktop on Sunday. It started to bleed today and sand will be put down to blot. Tom said that even if sand was applied some blows off because the road is not hot enough to bind to the sand. When asked what he observed on his inspection of the road he reported seeing little bubbles on the pavement.

Member Marcott moved with second by Member Trimmer to adjourn the meeting at 6:40 p. m.
