Chief Deputy Adam Cremer presented the monthly report. Jail average was 30, they have 22 in custody today, and the deputies handled 803 assorted incidents in November. The Public Aid savings on inmate medical in September and October \$1,295.72. They have been doing some deep cleaning in the cells.
