#### **Discuss New Tandem Purchase**

A discussion was held regarding the purchase of two new tandems. Engineer Crook received an estimate from Quincy Mac, it would be \$296,000.00 per truck, they would be 2026 models but they would receive them in 2025. Crook informed the Committee that she has about \$630,000.00 in her equipment fund and that there is approximately \$250,000.00 put in that fund every year.

#### **Prairie City Township RR Crossing Improvements**

Crook informed the Committee that the Railroad and Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC) received a grant to repair the crossing on 2200 North Road near Prairie City, there is also funding so that the road can be improved. The Highway Department will have to do the work on the road but the grant will pay for it.
